


INVESTING IN GENDER DIVERSITY



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Eliminate gender inequality could increase labour productivity by 25 % in many countries (World Bank, 2017)



The potential benefit of fully closing gender gaps in the workforce is of USD 28 trillion increase in global GDP, Gross Domestic Product, by 2025 (McKinsey Global Institute, 2017).



Companies that promote gender diversity on executive teams are 21% more likely to outperform on profitability and 27% more likely to have superior value creation. (McKinsey Global Institute, 2018)
