- Explore the fantastic Namdalen Coast by kayak

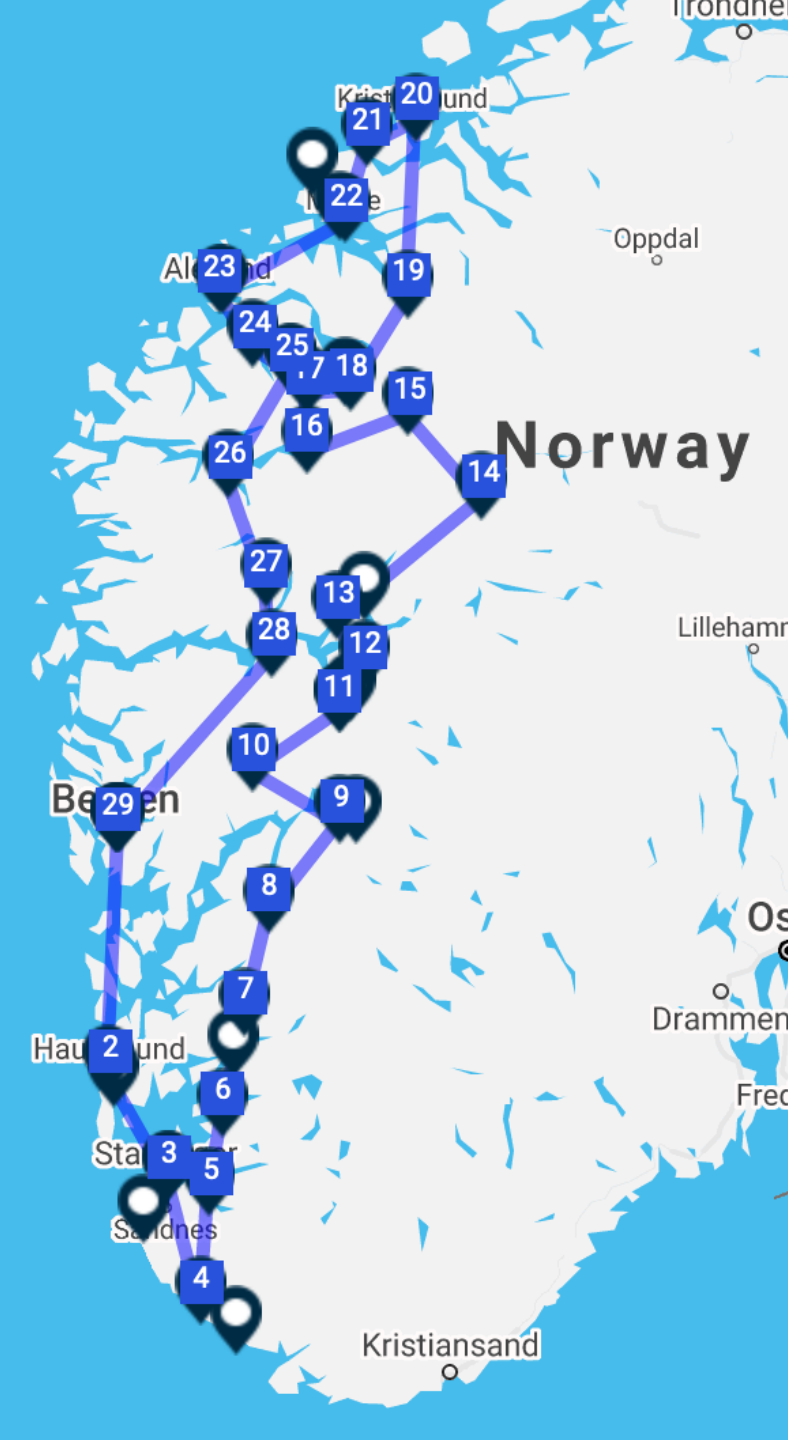



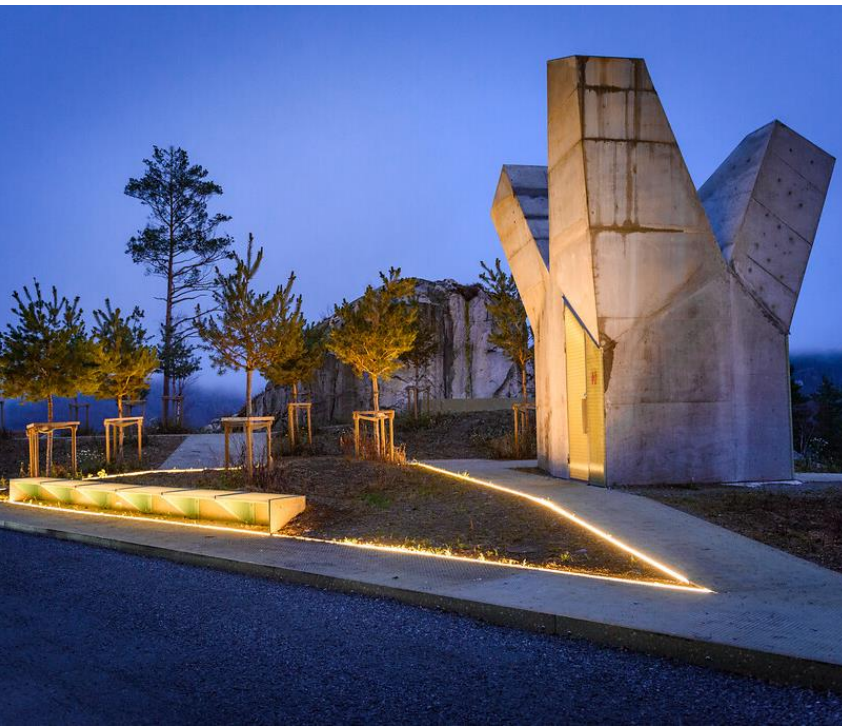

Geirangerfjord

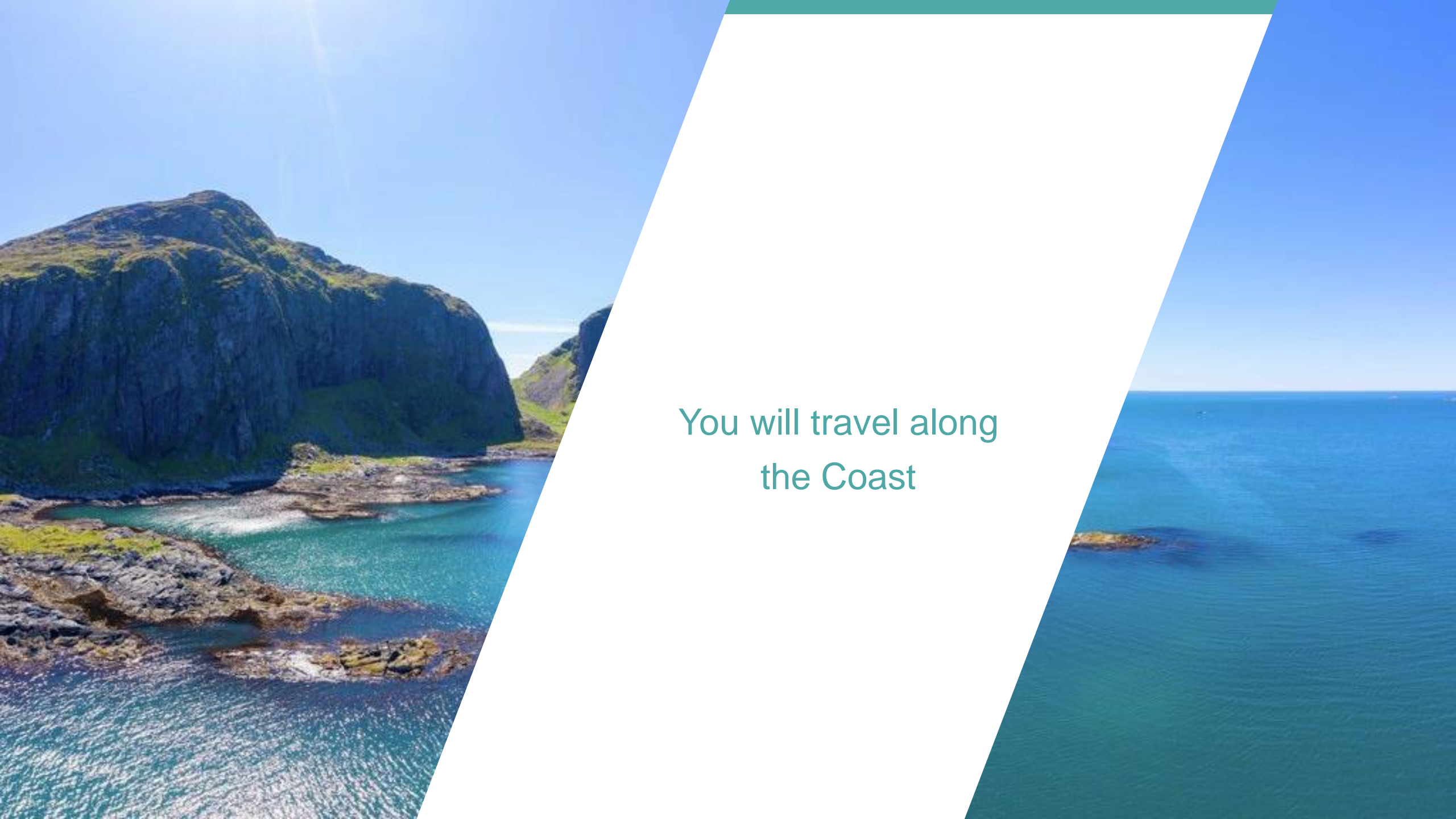
- Our most famous fjord
