





Hole in the CV

- Some of us have a hole in the CV
- Which means that you may not work for some years
- Explain why, in the coverletter
- Did you stay at home to take care of children?
- Did you try to find a job, but did not succeed?
- Did you study?



Just having a job vs career

It depends on your situation — It is ok

- Sometimes in life it is ok to «just» have a job
- When you are a student, you just need some income on the side
- When you first start out after your studies, you just need to get experience
- When you have small children, you just need some income



Coverletter

- Make sure that CV and coverletter is well written
- Do the research for each job
- Read about each company and their values and their up-coming projects

Coverletter

- Coverletter should only be one page
- Important to write about your motivation for the role and company

Example:

«I really want to be apart of your team because you are world leading in your field and I want to learn from the best»

<u>Or</u>

« It would be a honor to be apart of your team and work together towards sustainable solutions»

Coverletter

- Speak the «same language» as the company you are applying for
- If they use words like «sustainability, renewable energy, forwardthinking.....» use the same words in the coverletter
- They want to picture you in their company as a good fit



Call the recruiter

- Call the recruiter after you have sent in the application
- Ask a question and showcase yourself even more

What type of questions?

- Here you need to be pro-active and call the recruiter
- Get into a dialouge
- «I see that you are asking for someone with experience within the Tripletex system. I have worked in a similar system and can easily learn how to navigate in Tripletex as well.....»
- «How will the new project next year, impact this role?»
